

Informed Consent

The information contained within this leaflet is intended to provide you with an overview of the examination or treatment that you are to receive.

Prior to any medical procedure being carried out, the healthcare professional conducting the procedure will describe the nature of the examination or treatment you are to receive and will detail any risks associated with the procedure. It is your right to be given sufficient information to be able to make an informed decision as to whether you wish to continue with the examination/treatment or to refuse to undergo the procedure.

The nature of some examinations and treatment requires that your consent to continue must be given in writing and a form will be provided for you to sign. Some examinations may only require your verbal consent. For further information regarding our consent policy, please contact the Centre to which you have been referred.

Cornwall House Clinic is pleased to offer a confidential facial enhancing treatment delivered by a professional medical consultant, Dr Carl Mann.

Profile of Dr Mann

Dr Mann is a Consultant Neurologist with many years experience working at the University Hospital of North Staffordshire and at Cornwall House Clinic. He is a medical doctor, registered with the General Medical Council (GMC). He has expert medical knowledge of the facial map of nerves and muscles.

Dr Mann holds clinics for anti-ageing facial treatments and also for the treatments of muscle spasms, palsy of the face and dystonia.

About Anti Wrinkle Treatment

A simple, non surgical, anti wrinkle treatment that can temporarily smooth fine lines and wrinkles. One treatment and within a few days there is a visible difference to prominent facial lines.

The treatment is a purified protein produced by botulinum toxin, which reduces the movement of the muscles that cause fine lines and wrinkles to develop over time. It works by temporarily reducing the contractions of these muscles. Within days you can see an improvement that can last from three to six months.

Treatment at Cornwall House Clinic

After the initial consultation, Dr Mann will discuss with you whether he considers you to be an appropriate candidate for the treatment. If the treatment is carried out, it will normally take 10-15 minutes and you can go back to your normal daily life immediately.

Initial Consultation

For facial treatments, the consultation with Dr Mann will last for about 20-30 minutes and will cost £50. This fee is refundable if you have any treatments.

During the consultation Dr Mann will examine you and the muscle movements in your face, plus the nerves in the surrounding areas. Dr Mann will also discuss the procedure, anxieties, expectations and any other questions that you have about this treatment. A medical questionnaire will also need to be completed at this stage. By the end of the consultation, Dr Mann will let you know if he feels that you are an appropriate candidate for this treatment and the reasons for his decision.



Results

The most noticeable results will be seen from one to two weeks after your treatment. Results can last for three months and will fade gradually. You will be placed on our automatic recall database, which will generate a reminder for follow up treatments, should you wish to book.

Benefits

Your facial expression will become more relaxed but not mask like. The overall result of the treatment should give a natural look. If you have repeated treatments, you may find that lines and wrinkles in those areas become less pronounced and there can be longer intervals between treatments.

The most effective benefits are seen with treatment built up over a period of time. Heavier lines may require more than one treatment as they benefit from the cumulative effect. However treatments cannot correct lines caused by sun damage.
